literature. We can say, that these moments played an important role in his life, affected his

work. There are many autobiographical elements in his works. This part also briefly describes

the studies that examine the works of Jenő Rejtő. The novels "Az ellopott futár", "Piszkos

Fred, a kapitány" and the "A szőke ciklon" are also presented.

The practical part presents an interpretation of the novel mentioned above. This work

did not received as much attention as it deserved. In the first section of the practical part the

content of the novel "A tizennégy karátos autó" is described. The work presents the return

figures, although the characters don't have developed personalities, it is important to talk

about them. The next part presents some examples to prove the presence of parody. We can

find some examples of situation comedy, burlesque, cabaret scenes, and other forms of comic.

In his novel Jenő Rejtő refers to other works. These parallels are also presented in the last

part. This thesis tries to prove the presence of irony with these parallels.
